In 2019, Four Seasons Hotel One Dalton Boston (onedalton.com) entered the scene of luxury hospitality in Back Bay. The renowned building brought even more internationally acclaimed restaurants, like ever-popular Zuma as well as the One+One and Trifecta, along with endless views of the skyline, Charles River, Boston Harbor, Cambridge and more. Also tucked inside, however, are the shimmering Four Seasons Private Residences One Dalton, designed by the late legendary architect Henry Cobb of Pei Cobb Freed & Partners in collaboration with CambridgeSeven. “One Dalton’s soft triangular facade and floor-to-ceiling windows gracefully curve, framing the city’s breathtaking views and creating a tranquil living environment that centers the home,” says Cecily Foster, director of sales, of the residences. Also inside the unit sits a flexible space, which can serve as a dreamy home office or study. Looking to the bathrooms, a spa-inspired dreamland awaits—especially in the primary bath, where silver wave marble flooring quarried in Greece carries homeowners away into a blissful relaxation.
